SCRIPTURE: Luke 2:41-52

MEMORY VERSE: Ephesians 6:1

BIBLE STORY:

Mary and Joseph went every year to Jerusalem to attend the Feast of Passover. This religious ceremony was observed once a year. When Jesus was twelve years old, He was old enough and went with His mother Mary and Joseph to observe the ceremony.
